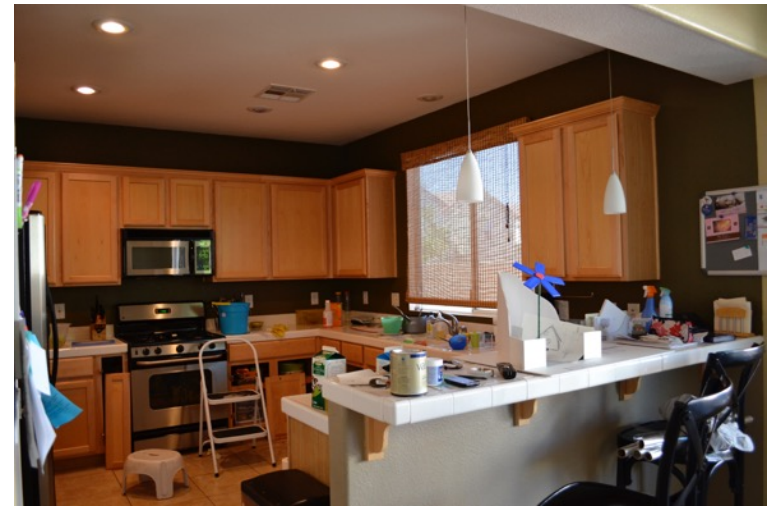
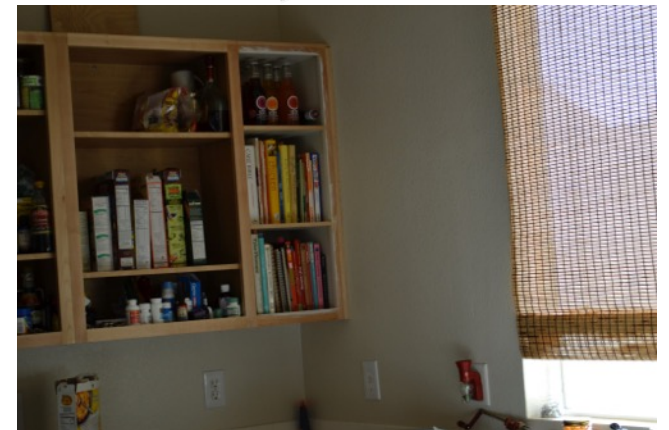


Kitchen

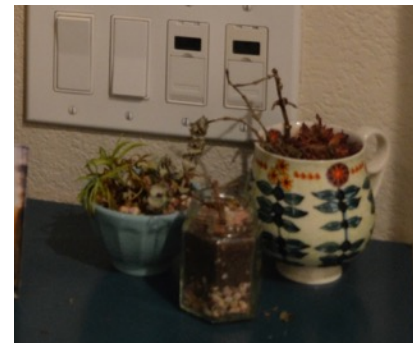
