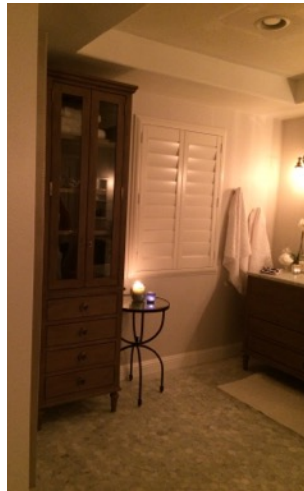
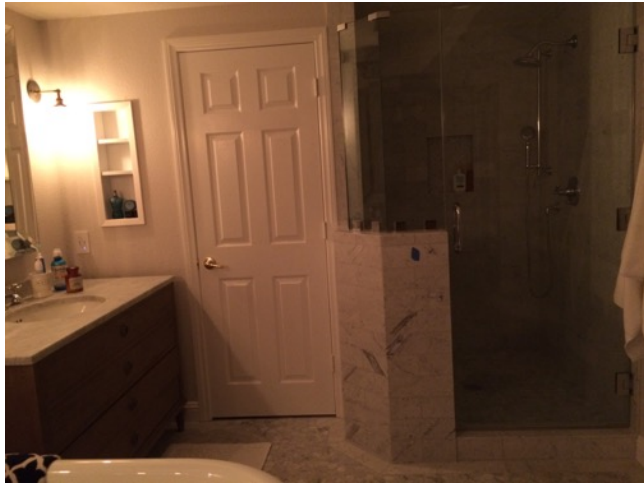


Master Bath and Closet

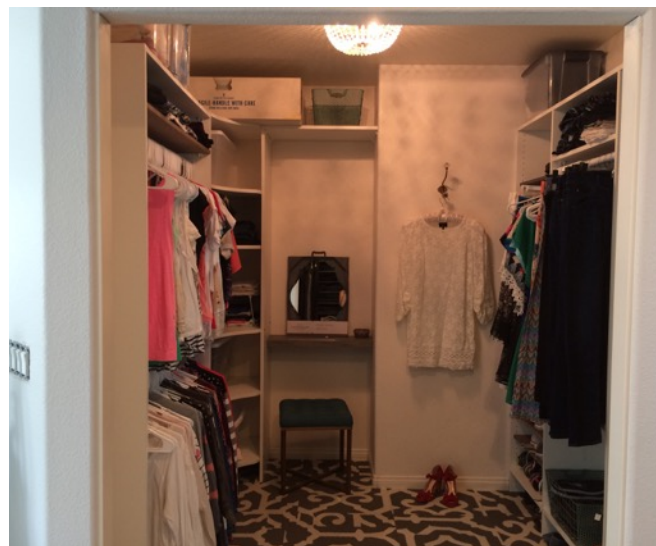


A clearer view of the colors in the space.
